

COVID-19 Home School Agreement- September 2020

In order to ensure the safety of all our staff, children and wider community we request that all parents sign to say they agree to the points outlined below that relate specifically to COVID-19.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child is in the clinically extremely vulnerable category and remains under the care of a specialist health professional I will need to discuss their care with them before returning to school in September (usually at their next planned clinical appointment) and ensure that school is made aware of any advice for a risk assessment to be completed.
- If my child or anyone in my household shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school. We will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know, as soon as possible, via telephone.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child immediately.
- I agree to follow the government advice on 'Track and Trace' <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/nhs-test-and-trace-how-it-works>
- When dropping off and collecting my child from school, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and will bring no additional people with me. I will be punctual and adhere to the school timings for my child.
- I will only use public transport if absolutely necessary and follow government guidance.
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school except stationery, exercise books, PE kit, a lunch box and water bottle.
- My child will need to regularly wash their hands/use hand sanitiser-
 - On arrival
 - After breaks and sporting activities
 - Before cooking / eating
 - After sneezing / coughing
 - Before and after using the toilet
 - Before leaving for home
- My child will follow good respiratory hygiene with the following procedure of "catch it, bin it, kill it".
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules when traveling to and from school.
- If my child chooses to wear a face covering on the way to school, they will be asked to remove it on entry to the site. They will be instructed not to touch the front of their face covering during use or when removing them. They must wash their hands immediately on arrival (as is the case for all pupils), dispose of temporary face coverings in a covered bin or place reusable face coverings in a plastic bag they can take home with them, and then wash their hands again before heading to their classroom.
- I will not be allowed into the school grounds without appointment and understand that communication will remain via Weduc and by phone/email.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers/other emergency contacts details.
- I understand that the adjusted behaviour policy and expectations will need to be followed by my child while accessing the school site.
