### Supporting with Level 2 Construction

The course content is split into the following key areas.

AC 1.1 Acts and regulations

AC1.2 Safety signs

AC 1.3 fire extinguishers

AC 1.2/1.3/2.1/3.1 Fires and fire extinguishers

AC 1.4 The health and safety executive

AC 2.1/2.2/2.3/3.1/3.2 Risks to health and safety in the workplace

AC 2.1/2.2/2.3//3.1/3.2 risks in health and safety

AC 4.1/4.2 C construction site security

Students need to complete each of the following 3 units to achieve their Level 2 qualification:

#### Unit 1: Health and Safety online exam.

1 hour. Short and extended answer questions.

#### Unit 2: Practical Construction Skills.

60 hr controlled assessment in lesson time. Practical activities and supporting written work.

#### Unit 3: Planning Construction Projects.

30 hr controlled assessment in lesson time. Planning Case Study - Students complete a planning project for constructing a dormitory building in Africa.
